Bela Fleck was born in New York City on July 10, 1958. He caught the banjo bug from the Beverly Hillbillies theme, and his first banjo came at age 15. He went to the New York City High School of Music and Art where he began on the French Horn but was quickly relegated to the choir (the banjo not being an acceptable instrument). He played in the band "Wicker's Creek" in the evenings. In 1980 he was hired by Sam Bush to play in his rebuilt *Newgrass Revival*. After nine years of intense touring and recording, they agreed to split up. While *Newgrass Revival* were active, Bela and Sam played in a band called *Strength In Numbers*. It formed out of the group of friends that always seemed to play on each other's records: Jerry Douglas, Mark O'Connor, Edgar Meyer, Sam Bush

and Bela. Their album, *The Telluride Sessions* has become a new acoustic classic. Bela had already met Victor and Roy ("Futureman") Wooten, and it only needed Howard Levy's phenomenal musical skills to be added for a new band to form. *Bela Fleck And The Flecktone* played their first gig on Bela's *Lonesome Pine Special* show and were signed by Warner Brothers.
