Boney M is a Eurodance, pop, and disco group, comprised of four West Indian singers and dancers and masterminded by German record producer Frank Farian, who have been successful since the 1970s. With their bubble gum infectious tunes, they have become one of the few Western groups to be well-known outside of the West, including Africa, Arab countries, South Asia, and Southeast Asia. To this day, along with Swedish pop group ABBA, they are among the most widely known western music acts in these regions. A musical based on the music of Boney M, *Daddy Cool*, is now open in London. In a sign of their continued popularity in South Asia, a concert by Boney M is a featured attraction at the 37th International Film Festival of India (IFFI), which began November 23, 2006 in Panaji, the state capital of Goa, India.
